

Notice of the CUPE Local 386 Elections

Election Date: Thursday, November 18, 2021 Polls are open from 8:00am to 10:30pm (online)

To vote, you must:

- E-mail the Union office at cupe386@shaw.ca to advise you wish to vote via Simply Voting, prior to registration cut off on November 17, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.
- Be sworn in as a CUPE 386 member. If you have not yet been sworn in, this can be done at the virtual AGM on November 16th, in office, or by calling the local at (604) 936-1810.

Information regarding the candidates will be continuously updated on the CUPE 386 website, which can be viewed at https://386.cupe.ca/.

Positions up for election:

- President (2 year term)
- Treasurer (2 year term)
- Chief Shop Steward* (2 year term)
- Executive at Large (inside one position, 2 year term)
- Executive at Large (outside one position, 2 year term)
- Trustee (one position, 3 year term)
- Bargaining Committee (3 positions + 1 alternate, 2 year term)

There is a one (1) months notice of "intent to run" required for the President's and Treasurer's positions, as such, nominations are closed for those positions as per CUPE Local 386's bylaws.

* The Chief Shop Steward will be elected by the Shop Steward Committee within one month after the November AGM, the election shall be held on the ODD numbered years.

Nominations for Election to Office:

All those eligible for nominations shall have been Members for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least three (3) General Membership Meetings within nine (9) calendar months prior to nominations for election. The exception shall be the President and Vice-President positions which shall be required to have been a Member for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least 50 percent of the General Membership Meetings within twenty—four (24) calendar months prior to nominations for election. No nomination shall be accepted unless the Member is in attendance at the nomination meeting or has allowed to be filed at such meeting, their consent in writing, duly witnessed by another Member. No Member may be elected to more than one (1) Office.
