Positions up for election:

- **Vice-President** (filling a vacancy).

The election for this position will take place via SimplyVoting on January 19th, 8:00am to 10:30pm and *requires separate registration*. Please see voting instructions below.

- **Alternate Bargaining Committee Member***

*All those eligible for nominations shall have been Members for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least three (3) General Membership Meetings within nine (9) calendar months prior to nominations for election. The exception shall be the President and Vice-President positions which shall be required to have been a Member for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least 50 percent of the General Membership Meetings within twenty-four (24) calendar months prior to nominations for election. No nomination shall be accepted unless the Member is in attendance at the nomination meeting or has allowed to be filed at such meeting, their consent in writing, duly witnessed by another Member.

Please note – this is a NEW election. Even if you had registered to vote in previous elections, you are required to register again if you wish to vote.

To vote for the Vice-President position, you *must*:

- E-mail the Union office at cupe386@shaw.ca to advise you wish to vote via Simply Voting, *up to the start of voting* on January 19th at 8:00 a.m.
- Be sworn in as a CUPE 386 member. If you have not yet been sworn in, this can be done at the virtual General Membership Meeting on January 18th, in the Union office, or by calling the local at (604) 936-1810.
