

Notice of Election

Positions up for Election:

Executive at Large (Outside). Term to run until elections at AGM in November 2025.

Young Worker (Under 30 years old at time of election) Term to run until elections at AGM in November 2026.

Form of Ballot: Simply Voting

To vote, you must:

- Register by emailing cupe386@shaw.ca with your Full Name and employee number by 8:00am on Feb 19th.
- Be sworn in as a CUPE 386 member. If you have not yet been sworn in, this can be done at the meeting on Feb 18th, by visiting the local office, or by calling the local at (604) 936-1810.
- Voting will take place on Feb 19th.
- Polls will be open 8am 8pm on Feb 19th.

*As per Article 6.1.5. of the Constitution and Bylaws, for the Office of President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Recording Secretary, eligible nominees must serve notice in writing of their intent to run for Office one (1) month prior to the commencement of election. For any other position, two (2) weeks written notice to run must be submitted to the union office prior to election.

******To be eligible for the Young Worker position you must be under 30 years old at the time of election

Nominations for Elections:

All those eligible for nominations shall have been Members for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least three (3) General Membership Meetings within nine (9) calendar months prior to nominations for election. The exception shall be the President and Vice-President positions which shall be required to have been a Member for at least twelve (12) months and have attended at least 50 percent of the General Membership Meetings within twenty–four (24) calendar months prior to nominations for election. No nomination shall be accepted unless the Member is in attendance at the nomination meeting or has allowed to be filed at such meeting, their consent in writing, duly witnessed by another Member. No Member may be elected to more than one (1) Office.
