Good of the Union

- 5.1.3 Should any Officer fail to answer the roll call for three (3) General meetings and or Executive meetings in a row, without having submitted a good reason to be accepted by the Executive Committee for such absence, the Office can be declared vacant by the Executive Committee, and the position filled by an election upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee at the following General Membership meeting.
- 5.1.3 Should any Officer fail to answer the roll call for three (3) consecutive General meetings and or three (3) consecutive Executive meetings in a row, without having submitted a good reason to be accepted by the Executive Committee for such absence, the Office can will be declared vacant by the Executive Committee, and the position filled by an election upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee at the following General Membership meeting.
- 6.4.5 The method of election shall be by secret ballot or online voting. For in person elections, each candidate for office shall be entitled to appoint a Scrutineer to oversee the counting of ballots on their behalf. Any Scrutineer so appointed shall also treat the information overseen by them in connection with the ballot count as confidential. Immediately following the close of voting, the Returning Officer and/or the Balloting Committee and any Scrutineers shall proceed to count the ballots. Upon completion of the count, the Returning Officer shall notify the Presiding Officer and report the results immediately.
- 6.4.5 The method of election shall be by secret ballot or online voting which will be displayed on the election notice prior to the election. For in person elections, each candidate for office shall be entitled to appoint a Scrutineer to oversee the counting of ballots on their behalf. Any Scrutineer so appointed shall also treat the information overseen by them in connection with the ballot count as confidential. Immediately following the close of voting, the Returning Officer and/or the Balloting Committee and any Scrutineers shall proceed to count the ballots. Upon completion of the count, the Returning Officer shall notify the Presiding Officer and report the results immediately.
